FREQUENTLY ASKED GRADUATION RATES QUESTIONS

1. Who is a first time student?

A first-time student has no prior postsecondary experience before enrolling at this school. This means that a student who attended another postsecondary school before enrolling at this school will not be included in the calculation. The rate also does not include students enrolled part-time, taking individual classes (as compared to enrolling in a full program), or only auditing classes.

2. How are the graduation rates calculated?

The rates are calculated using the Student Right to Know formula in order to comply with U.S. Department of Education requirements. The statistics track all first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students who began school during the specified date range and have graduated within 150% of the normal program length. For example, for a two- year program, the graduation rate would include students who have graduated within three years of beginning the program.
